ADIRONDACK TRUST COMPANY COMMUNITY FUND ANNOUNCES 2015 AUTUMN OF GIVING MATCH CAMPAIGN RESULTS

Saratoga Springs, New York.... The Adirondack Trust Company Community Fund announced today that it recently concluded the 2015 Autumn of Giving Match Campaign. The Campaign raised a grand total of \$80,302 to benefit local charities through the ATCCF Lend-A-Hand Grant Program. During the month long campaign, \$40,151 was donated by the community and business partners. Plus, The Adirondack Trust Company matched all donations, dollar for dollar, for another \$40,151. The community-wide initiative brought thirteen participating business partners, The Adirondack Trust Company, and local citizens together to increase awareness of the Community Fund, and raise funds to support area nonprofits. Since its inception in 2013, the Autumn of Giving Campaign has raised over \$125,000 from the community. With the bank match, the overall total now raised exceeds \$250,000.

Speaking on behalf of the ATCCF Advisory Committee, volunteer Chairperson, Mary Gavin, noted: "We are very grateful to the individual donors, business partners and media partners, as well as The Adirondack Trust Company, for their generous support. Our community is what makes this event such a success each year. As a result of the funds now available, the 2015 Lend-A-Hand Grant Awards (to be presented on December 15) will provide support to twenty three local nonprofits; each with a very worthy mission. It is because of the work of these nonprofits that our community continues to grow and thrive. Thank you to everyone who helped make the campaign a great success!"

The Fund is an independent 501(c) (3) charitable organization.
